

Middle School Dress Code

TOPS

Collared tops are encouraged.

SES T- shirts are allowed every day.

Collarless tops are allowed, but the top must have a partial sleeve- no tank tops. No low-cut, revealing necklines are allowed.

No shirts that show off a bare midriff are allowed.

No athletic jerseys are allowed; no graphics or writing. One exception: sweatshirts are allowed with an SES logo or a college logo.

PANTS

All pants must be clean and without tears or rips. No particular colors or fabrics are required.

Shorts must be longer than the farthest tip of the fingers of a fully extended arm.

Leggings are allowed, but the top must be longer than the farthest tip of the fingers of a fully extended arm.

No athletic gear is allowed.

SKIRTS/DRESSES

All skirts and dresses must be longer than the farthest tip of the fingers of a fully extended arm. Leggings under skirts are allowed.

SHOES

All shoes must be solid, sturdy, and safe for both indoor **and** outdoor use.

No sandals, Crocs, open-toed shoes or cleats are allowed.

HATS/SUNGLASSES

Hats and sunglasses may only be worn outside.

JEWELRY, ACCESSORIES, HAIR COLOR, and “FIT”

Jewelry, accessories, and hair color should not interrupt the learning process of any student. And, please, no oversized clothing!
